



Coach Developer Traineeship Programme

Delivered in Partnership between New Level Soccer Academy and Creative Sport & Leisure Ltd



Overview

This 20 week traineeship is designed for young people who are enthusiastic, professional and wanting to pursue a career in coaching football. On the programme you will develop your coaching skills, gain valuable work experience with New Level Soccer Academy and improve your employability, maths and English skills.

What qualifications will I study?

As part of the programme you will complete the following qualifications:

- Certificate in Coaching (Sport and Physical Activity) (L2)
- Award in the Principles of Leading an Active, Healthy Life (EL3)
- Functional Skills in both English & Maths
- Employability Skills
- Award in Mental Health Awareness (L2)

What will a typical week involve?

Your week will be made up of two days of learning at New Level Soccer Academy, where you will spend one day working towards your coaching qualification and then move onto your active healthy life and mental health awareness qualifications. The second day will be spent improving your employability skills and working towards a maths and English qualification. You will also complete 3 days of work experience with

You will also complete 3 days of work experience with New Level Soccer, these duties will include:

 Working with young people, promote and encourage development of technical and performance skills, creativity and confidence.

- Delivering a weekly programme of football coaching sessions to children.
- Ensuring provision of a safe and healthy environment ensuring all policies adhered to at all times.
- Promote the work of the New Level Soccer Team within local communities.
- Administration including Health and Safety, checking of facilities and equipment. Registers of attendance.

Who is eligible for the programme?

- You must be aged 16-19 or up to 25 if you have an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP). Please note if you are 19 and do not have and EHCP you will not be eligible for the programme if you turned 19 on or before the 31st of August 2021
- You must not be qualified at L4 or above
- You are not currently in full-time employment or funded education and have little work experience, but are focused on work or the prospect of it

Are there any other entry requirements?

- No experience required.
- Must be reliable & punctual.
- Be a role model and mentor to the children.
- Being part of a community-based team.
- Desire and commitment to individual/team development & growth.

What are my progression opportunities?

There is the potential for trainees to be offered a part-time position as a recognised coach within the New Level Soccer Academy on completion of this programme.

*Trainees can earn up to £30 a week for the duration of the programme to cover travel expenses.
