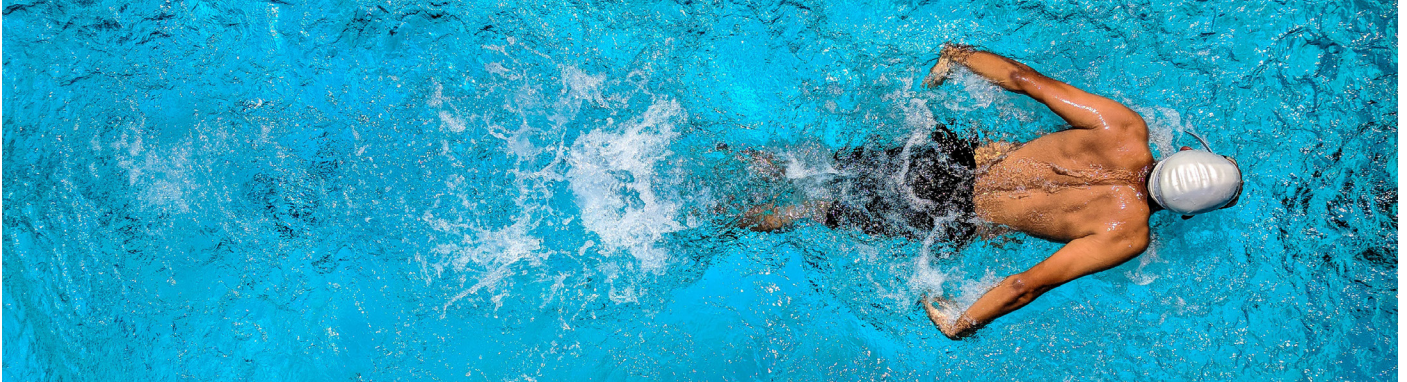


Lifeguard and Swim Teacher Traineeship Programme

Delivered in partnership between Creative Sport & Leisure Ltd and Trafford Leisure.



Overview

This 12 week traineeship programme is for anyone aged 16-24 wanting to pursue a career in the leisure industry. Trafford Leisure are the largest operator of sport and leisure facilities in Trafford. Throughout their leisure facilities, they offer support, guidance and motivate people and communities to get healthy and be active. On the programme you will develop your lifeguard and swim teacher skills, gain valuable work experience, improve your employability, maths and English skills.

What qualifications will I study?

As part of the programme you will complete the following qualifications:

- L2 National Pool Lifeguard Qualification
- SEQ L1 Swimming Assistant (Teaching)
- Award in the Principles of Leading an Active, Healthy Life (EL3)
- Functional Skills in both English & Maths
- Employability Skills

What will a typical week involve?

Your week will be made up of two days of learning at Trafford Leisure, where you will spend one day working towards your Lifeguard and Swim Assistant qualification and then move onto your Award in the Principles of Leading an Active, Healthy Life. The second day will be spent improving your employability skills and working towards a maths and English qualification.

You will also complete 3 days work experience with Trafford Leisure, these duties will include:

- Supervising swimming activity
- Delivering venue cleanliness and housekeeping standards to the highest level

- Giving excellent supporter service in a professional manner, to encourage repeat visits
- Assisting with poolside set up for swimming lessons
- Assisting swim teachers with delivery of lessons either in the water or from the side

Who is eligible for the programme?

- You must be aged 16-24 or up to 25 if you have an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP)
- You must not be qualified at L4 or above
- You are not currently in full-time employment or funded education and have little work experience, but are focused on work or the prospect of it
- Live in England
- UK or EU citizen for 3 years or more

Are there any other entry requirements?

- Good listening and communication skills
- IT Skills
- Attention to detail and presentation skills
- Basic organisational skills and able to follow instructions
- Customer care skills
- Problem solving skills and can demonstrate logical team working
- Creative and works with initiative
- Patient and non judgemental

What are my progression opportunities?

Upon successful completion of the programme, Trafford Leisure will be recruiting Leisure Team Member apprentices, starting February 2023.

*Trainees can earn up to £30 a week for the duration of the programme to cover travel expenses.
